Genesis 1:26-27

John 14:16-17

John 15:26

“But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.

From Christian Center Statement of Faith

The Trinity: We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (*Matt 28:18-19, 2 Cor 13:14*)

Creeds

Nicene Creed

Revised by the First Council of Constantinople

And in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of life, who proceedeth from the Father, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spake by the prophets.

Creeds

Athanasian Creed

We worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity;
Neither confounding the Persons; nor dividing the
Essence. For there is one Person of the Father;
another of the Son; and another of the Holy Ghost.
But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of
the Holy Ghost, is all one; the Glory equal, the
Majesty coeternal.

The Shield of the Trinity

The Latin reads: "The Father is God, The Son is God, The Holy Spirit is God; God is the Father, God is the Son, God is the Holy Spirit;

The Father is not the Son, The Son is not the Father, The Father is not the Holy Spirit, The Holy Spirit is not the Father, The Son is not the Holy Spirit, The Holy Spirit is not the Son."
