Dragon = Satan



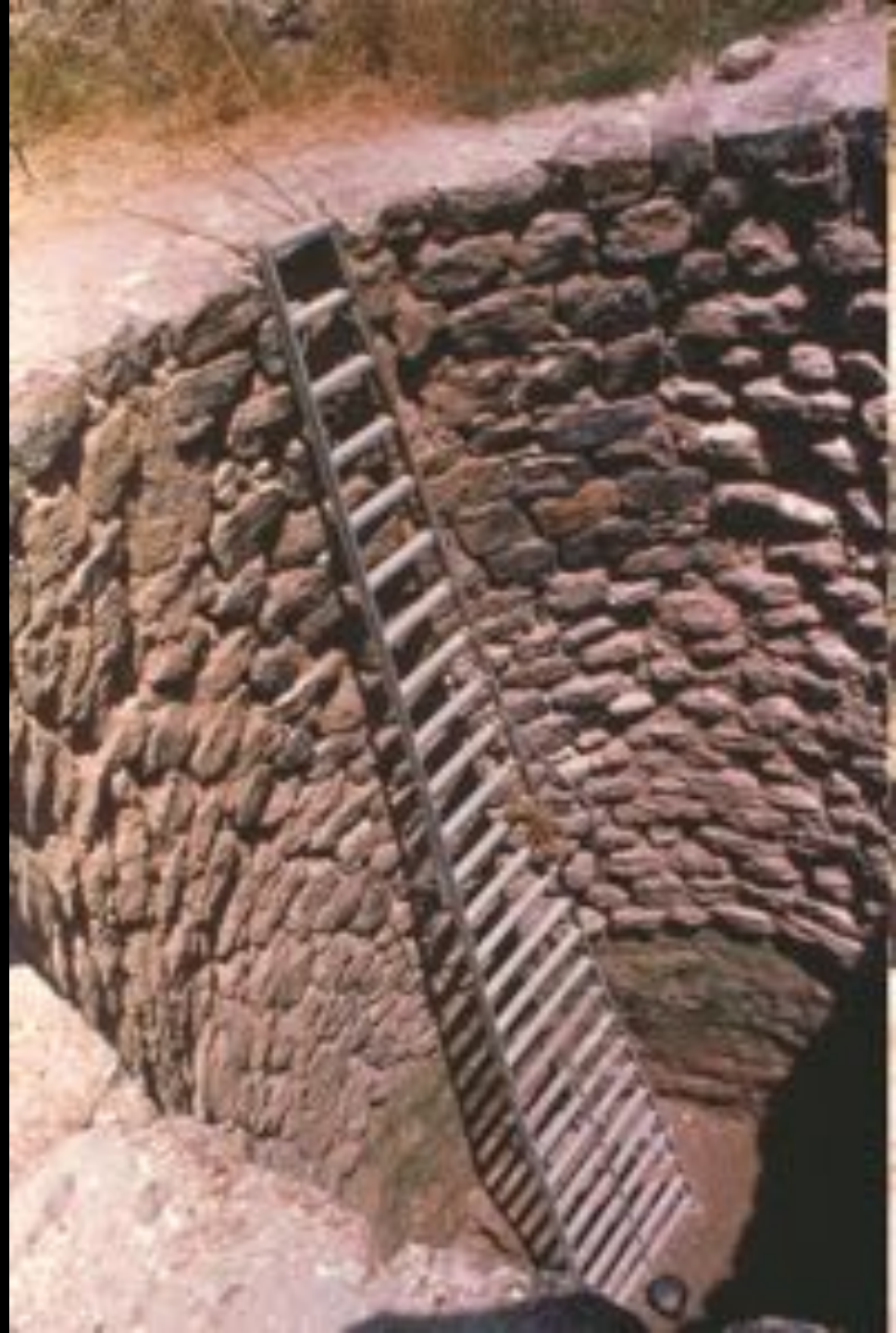

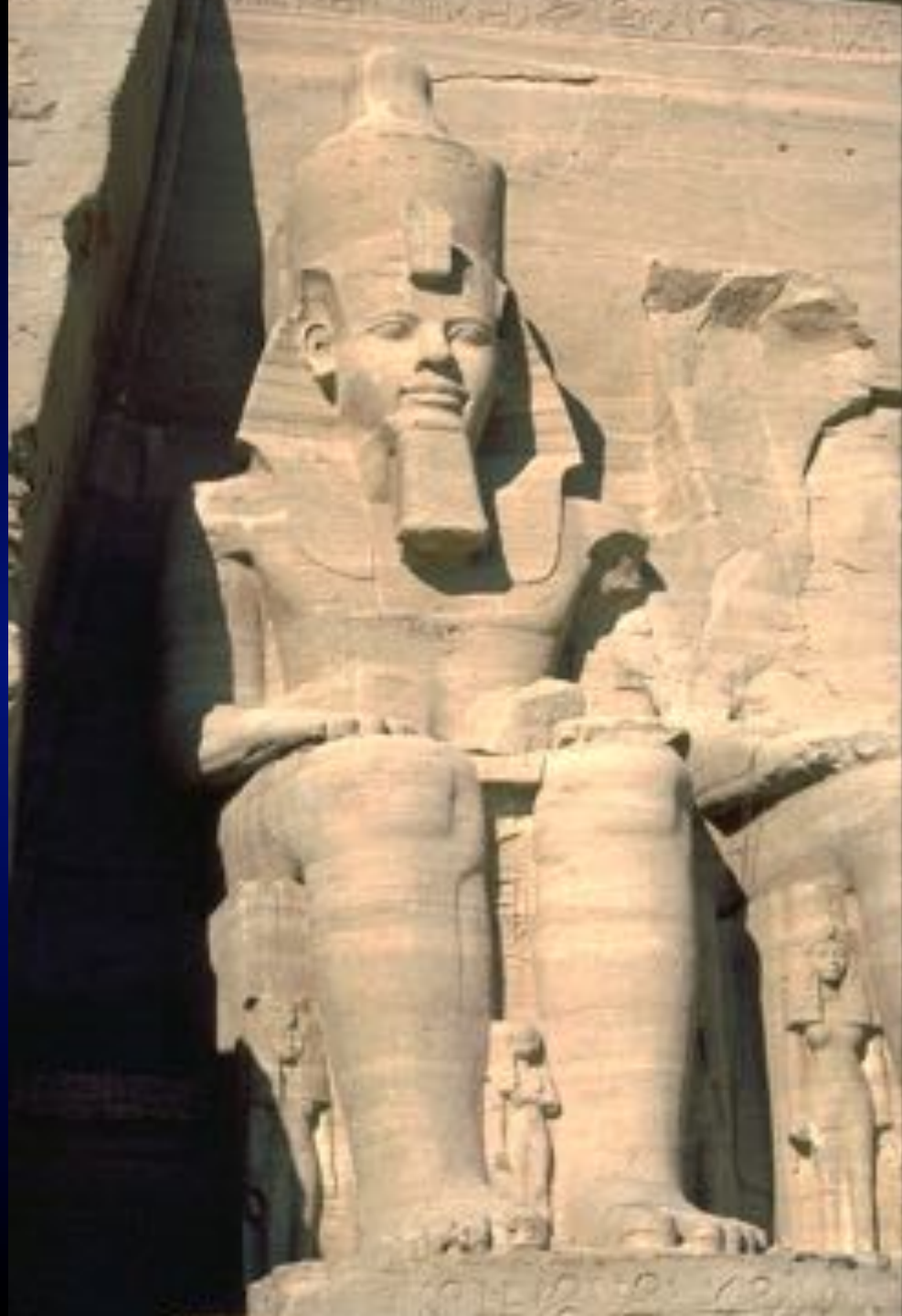

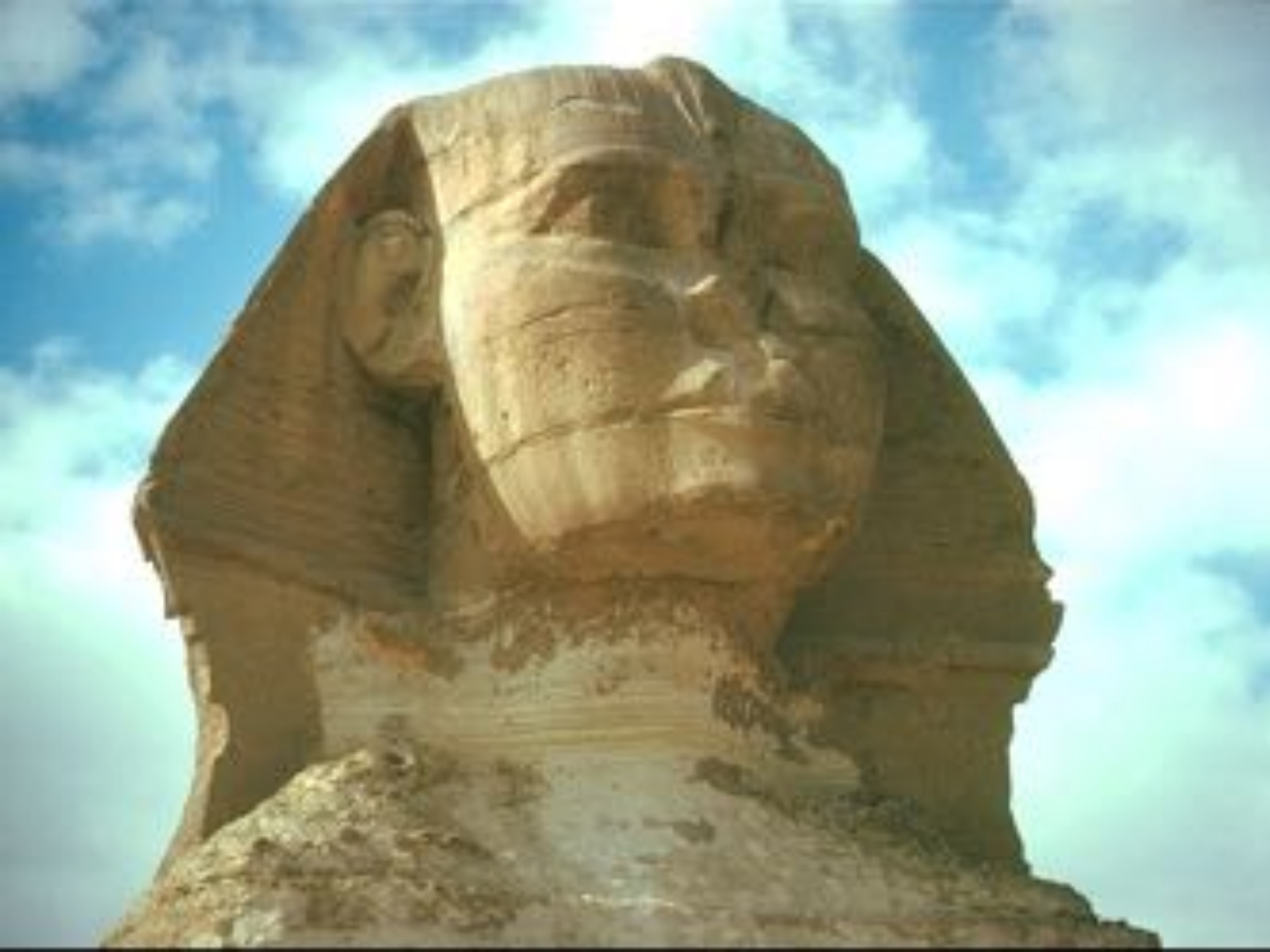
