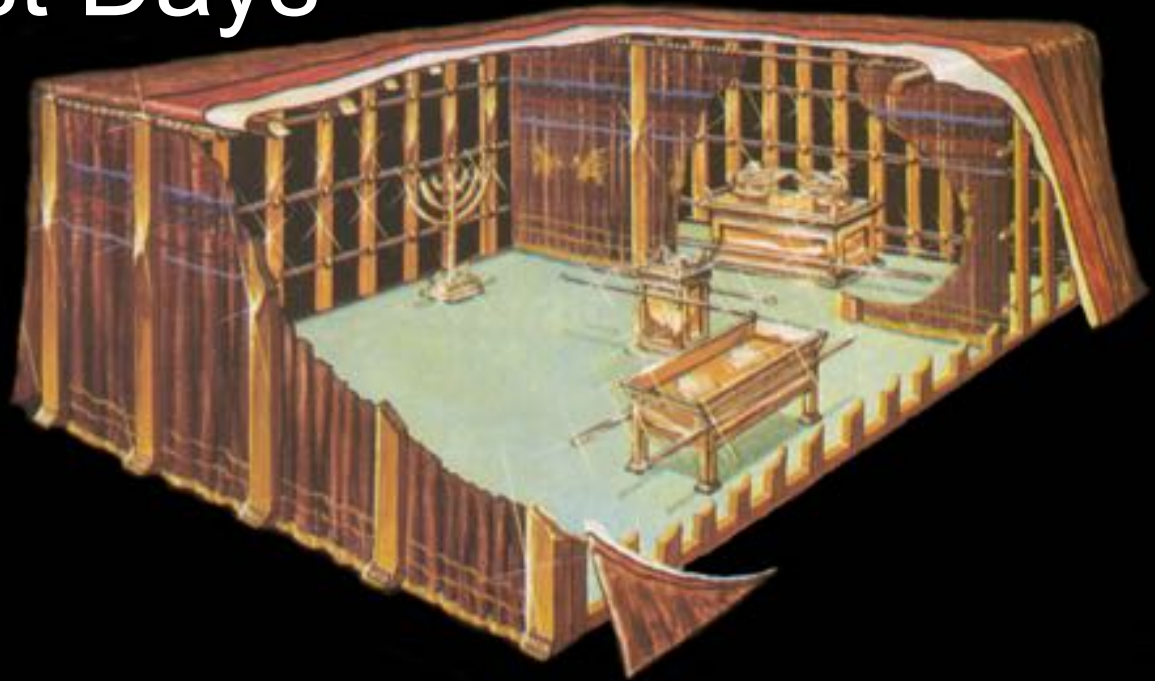

# LOVE

## **Deuteronomy 7:7–8**
