HORSES

2 Chronicles 9:25

Solomon had four thousand stalls for horses and chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen whom he stationed in the chariot cities and with the king at Jerusalem.



HORSES

1 Kings 10:26

And Solomon gathered chariots and horsemen; he had one thousand four hundred chariots and twelve thousand horsemen, whom he stationed in the chariot cities and with the king at Jerusalem.

1 Kings 10:28

Also Solomon had horses imported from Egypt...



HORSES

Isaiah 31:1

Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help,
And rely on horses, Who trust in chariots
because *they are* many, And in horsemen
because they are very strong, But who do not
look to the Holy One of Israel, Nor seek the
LORD!



WEALTH

1 Kings 10:14

The weight of gold that came to Solomon yearly was six hundred and sixty-six talents of gold,

1 Kings 10:27

The king made silver *as common* in Jerusalem as stones, and he made cedar trees as abundant as the sycamores which *are* in the lowland.



WIVES

1 Kings 11:1

But King Solomon loved many foreign women, as well as the daughter of Pharaoh: women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Sidonians, *and* Hittites—
