Charles Russell

Ross exposed Russell as a pseudo-scholar, who never attended the higher schools of learning, is totally ignorant of the dead languages, and was never ordained.


Russell claimed high scholastic ascendancy, recognized theological training, and working knowledge of the dead languages (Greek, Hebrew, etc.) and valid ordination by a recognized body.

Question (Attorney Staunton): "Do you know the Greek alphabet?"

Answer (Russell): "Oh yes."

Question (Attorney Staunton): "Can you tell me the correct letters if you see them?"

Answer (Russell): "Some of them; I might make a mistake on some of them."





Answer (Russell): "Well, I don't know that I would be able to."


Question (Attorney Staunton): "You can't tell what those letters are? Look at them and see if you know."

Question (Attorney Staunton): "Are you familiar with the Greek language?"


Answer (Russell): "No."

- 3. The fact that they don't allow blood transfusions








Jehovah's Witnesses are taught that to please Jehovah, it would be better to allow their young child (who has perhaps been bitten by a rattlesnake) to die in the hospital room, rather than give her a blood transfusion that would save her life.

Beliefs Salvation

"...there will only be one organization—God's visible organization—that will survive the fast-approaching "great tribulation." It is simply not true that all religions lead to the same goal. You must be part of Jehovah's organization, doing God's will, in order to receive his blessing of everlasting life."

If you want to be sure that you will be saved at the battle of Armageddon the Watchtower teaches that you must be faithful and active in what they call "kingdom work," which for them is mainly door to door ministry. (See You Can Live Forever in Paradise on Earth, p.25off)







- He is *not* coming again; he already "returned" invisibly in 1914 in spirit.
- Very soon, he and the angels will destroy all non-Jehovah's Witnesses.

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?



■ Instead, the "holy spirit" is an invisible, active force from Jehovah.

HOW TO BE SAVED

- Be baptized as a Jehovah's Witness.
- Most followers must earn everlasting life on earth by "door-to-door work."
- Salvation in heaven is limited to 144,000
 "anointed ones." (This number has already been reached.)





Watchtower Bible and Tract Society

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER DEATH

- The 144,000 "anointed ones" live as spirits in heaven.
- The rest of the righteous ("the great crowd") live on earth and must obey God perfectly for 1,000 years or be annihilated.





Watchtower Bible and Tract Society

OTHER BELIEFS AND PRACTICES

- Meet in "Kingdom Halls instead of churches."
- Active members are encouraged to distribute literature door-to-door.
- Once a year, members observe "Lord's Evening Meal" (like communion); only "anointed ones" may actually partake.





Watchtower Bible and Tract Society

OTHER BELIEFS AND PRACTICES

- Members are *not* allowed to...
 - observe holidays or birthdays
 - vote
 - salute the flag
 - work in the military
 - accept blood transfusions
