Polygamy Exposed



Joseph Smith wound up in jail in Carthage, Illinois, crowd of 200 attacked.

Brigham Young, won a power struggle and led many to Salt Lake where they settled in 1847.





A significant minority, headed by Smith's wife Emma and son Joseph the III led followers in Missouri and Illinois and formed the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, head quartered in Independence, Missouri.



A more positive public image was sought to gain more converts.

A new strategy which claimed, "Mormonism is Christianity; Christianity is Mormonism; they are one and the same."



# WHO IS GOD?

- God the Father was once a man, but "progressed" to godhood.
- God the Father has a physical body, as does his wife (generally called "Heavenly Mother").
- No Trinity.
  - Father, Son, and "Holy Ghost" are three separate gods.
- Worthy men may one day become gods themselves.





Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints





- The Mormon Jesus is a separate god from the Father (Elohim).
  - He was created as a spirit child by the Father and Mother in Heaven, and is the "elder brother" of all men and spirit beings.

# WHO IS JESUS?

- His body was created through sexual union between Elohim and Mary.
- He was married.
- His death on the cross does not provide full atonement for all sin, but does provide everyone with resurrection.

# WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

- In Mormonism, the "holy spirit" is different from the "Holy Ghost."
- The "holy spirit" is not God, but is instead an influence or electricity-like emanation from God.
- The "holy spirit" is also called the "light of Christ."







### Black Ordained to Mormon Priesthood

SALT LAKE CITY 49.—Joseph Freeman Jr., a 26-yearold telephone repairman, Sunday became the first black ordained to the priesthood of the Mormon Church. The church dropped its restriction against blacks Friday. "I don't know if words can describe how I feel," Free-

"I don't know if words can describe how I feet," Preeman said. "It's something we've waited a long time for." Spenrer W. Kimball, president of the Church of Jesus

Spencer W. Kimball, preddent of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and his two counselors announced Priday that the church would no longer keep black males from the priesthood. He said a "revelation, had come after hours of "supplicating the Lord for divine guidance."

The prohibition had prevented black males from entering the priesthood, for which all other males, 12 years of older and in good standing, were eligible.

Preeman was ordained an elder, one of six offices in the Morroon priesthood. The position generally is conferred 4 age 19. The other offices are deacon, teacher, priest, Countril of Seventy and high priest.



- Christian doctrine became thoroughly corrupted





# Mormonism Claims...

Genuine or Fraud?

- According to tenth LDS president Joseph Fielding Smith, Mormonism must stand or fall on the story of Joseph Smith
- "He was either a prophet of God...or one of the biggest frauds this world has ever seen"





### The Bible Teaches...

Testing Prophets

God provided two main tests to determine a prophet's legitimacy:

- 1. Represents the true God of the Hebrews
  - 1. Deuteronomy 13:1-3
- 2. Correctly foretells the future
  - 1. Deuteronomy 18:20-22





### You Should Also Know...

Testing Prophets

- Joseph Smith denied the biblical view of God
- He falsely predicted that a war between the States would literally become a world war

### You Should Also Know...

Testing Prophets

- The Bible warns against adding to or taking away from what God has commanded
- Joseph Smith produced his own version of the Bible in which he removed some parts and inserted others








### Mormonism Claims...

Four "Standard Works"

Mormonism teaches that the Bible has been corrupted and is accepted only with qualifications







### Mormonism Claims...

Continuing Revelation

- We are also to accept the words of Mormonism's living prophets
- Their scriptures are not "closed," meaning that some doctrines may be changed or added



### You Should Also Know...

Joseph Smith's Bible

- Doctrine and Covenants 73:4 states that God commanded Joseph Smith to finish a new translation of the Bible
- This Bible, known as the *Inspired Version* or *Joseph Smith Translation* (JST), wasn't really a translation at all





### You Should Also Know...


Joseph Smith's Bible

- Smith had no ancient manuscripts, nor was he fluent in any biblical language
- Rather than consult ancient texts, Smith merely "corrected" whatever he felt was necessary
- Smith even added a prophecy of his own birth to Genesis 50:33






### Mormonism Claims...

Unreliable Scripture

- The LDS church affirms that the Bible is the word of God "as far as it is translated correctly"
- "The Bible has suffered the loss of many plain and precious parts"



Reliable Revelations

### You Should Also Know...

Reliable Revelations

- Most LDS criticism of the Bible alleges faulty "transmission"
- Mormons are taught that the Bible has been dishonestly revised
- Thus, many Mormons are slow to reexamine their faith when Bible passages contradict LDS teachings



### You Should Also Know...

Reliable Revelations

- Critical examination of biblical manuscripts allows us to determine what the original writers wrote
- Manuscript differences are essentially minor








### Mormonism Claims...

### Miraculous Translation

- Mormons teach that The Book of Mormon
  - is a translation of an ancient document
- Joseph Smith interpreted the characters on gold plates that the angel Moroni gave him in 1827

Ancient Peoples

The Book of Mormon gives an account of three people groups that migrated to the American continents "between about 2,000 BC and AD 400"







Biblical Prophecy


The LDS church teaches that the Book of Mormon was foretold in Ezekiel 37:16, 17, in which the "sticks" described are two books: the Bible and the Book of Mormon



### The Bible Teaches...

Nations—Not Books

- The Hebrew word for "stick" is never used in connection with books
- In Ezekiel 37:18-23, the sticks represent two nations—the ten northern tribes of Israel and the two southern tribes of Judah






### You Should Also Know...

Missing Evidence

- The Book of Mormon is published without maps
- The LDS church cannot locate even one unique Book of Mormon city
- The LDS church has failed to provide undisputed proof that the peoples it describes really existed



### You Should Also Know...

Historical Problems

- The Book of Mormon's 19th-century origin is exposed by the way it quotes passages from the New Testament
- It mentions topics relating to freemasonry and doctrinal controversies that were hotly disputed during Smith's lifetime





### You Should Also Know...

Other Problems

The Book of Mormon mentions types of animals, weaponry, and plants

which were not present in the New World during the Book of Mormon time period






### You Should Also Know...

Other Problems

New DNA research undermines the Mormon claim that the "Lamanites" are actually of Semitic origin

Many Gods

- Our God was once a mortal man who became God by obeying eternal laws and principles







- The view of God held by millions of Christians is a perversion of the truth










#### The Bible Teaches...


Coming Again—But Not Yet

Immortality for All

Grace vs. Perfect Repentance


- In Mormonism, "those who receive forgiveness and then repeat the sin are held accountable for their former sins"






#### The Bible Teaches...

#### Don'T...

assume that a Mormon defines a word in the same way you do.

#### **Do...**

define your terms — and have them define theirs.








#### DON'T...

assume you already know what an individual Mormon believes.

- Not all Mormons agree with their leaders.
- This could be because they are not aware of what their leaders have taught.



ask Mormons

 Rather than accusing, ask them a question.









#### DON'T...

dwell on offensive or peripheral issues.

Talking about the temple ceremony, the sacred garments, polygamy or racism will almost certainly bring the discussion to a close.







concentrate on core issues.

- Find out what the Mormon believes about God the Father, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, and salvation.
- Ask if they have the assurance that all of their sins are forgiven.



#### DON'T...

be surprised if Mormons are suspicious of Christian literature.

- Mormons often feel that information written about their church is inaccurate.
- Instead, ask Mormons to show you where the information might be wrong.





Do...

memorize certain points and quotes.

- Quote directly from Mormon sources if possible.
- Remember that statements from LDS leaders work best.







#### DON'T...

try to cover every topic in one sitting.

 dealing with one or two subjects makes it easier to remember what you talked about.

#### **Do...**

- be patient.
  - Leaving their church is not a decision most
     Mormons make in an instant.
