Resurrection Foretold

Hebrews 11:17-19

By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called," concluding that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

The Resurrection

Resurrection Evidence

Simon Greenleaf, Royal Professor of Law at Harvard University, examined the value of the historical evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ to ascertain the truth. This noted legal authority came to the conclusion that, according to the laws of legal evidence used in courts of law, "There is more evidence for the historical fact of the resurrection of Jesus Christ than for just about any other event in history."
