Mark to Romans, emphasizes the Servant

Luke to Gentiles, emphasizes His humanity

John to the World, emphasizes His deity

Mark and Paul

...Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry.

Mark and Peter

1 Peter 5:13

She who is in Babylon, elect together with *you*, greets you; and so *does* Mark my son.

Isaiah 53:4–5


