3 ANNUAL FEASTS

Deuteronomy 16:16

3 ANNUAL FEASTS

A boy became a “son of the covenant,” a custom continued in the present bar-mitzvah ceremony. It was considered helpful for a boy to attend the Jerusalem festivals for one or two years before becoming a son of the covenant so that he would realize what his new relationship involved.

FATHER'S BUSINESS / HOUSE

The Greek text is elliptical here and reads, "I must be in the ... of my Father," without specifying a place or activity. Either Jesus must be about the work of God, as the translation suggests; or he must be in the house of God, discussing God's truth. In the end the two possibilities are not very different.
