Isaiah 53:3-5, 12

1 Corinthians

Chapter 1:18-31

Righteousness = to be in a proper or right relation with God

Sanctification = set apart, dedicated to a sacred purpose

Redemption = a releasing effected by payment of ransom

Righteousness = *saved* from the penalty of sin

Sanctification = *being saved* from the power of sin

Redemption = *shall be saved* from the presence of sin
