For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand.



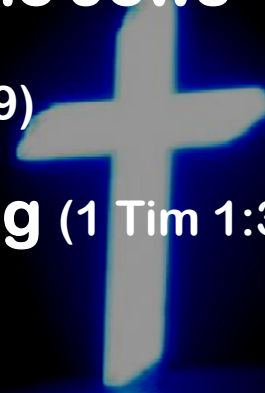
Timothy
