PAUL'S EARLY TRAVELS

- City
- ← Paul journeys from Jerusalem to Damascus to seek out Christians (*Acts 9:1ff*)
- ← Paul spends time in Arabia (*Gal 1:17*)
- ← Paul returns to Jerusalem (*Acts 9:26ff*)
- ← Paul flees from Jerusalem to Tarsus (*Acts 9:28ff*)
- ← Barnabas journeys from Antioch to Tarsus to bring Paul to Antioch (*Acts 11:25ff*)
- ← Paul and Barnabas sent on mission to Jerusalem (*Acts 11:29ff*)
- ← Paul, Barnabas, and John Mark travel from Jerusalem to Antioch (*Acts 12:25*)

BARNABAS

Generous believer in the early church Acts 4

Brought Saul to the apostles Act 9

Sent to revival in Antioch from Jerusalem Acts 11

Gets Paul from Tarsus to help in the work Acts 11

Takes famine relief to Jerusalem with Paul Acts 11

Goes on Paul's 1st missionary journey Acts 13-14

Goes with Paul to the Jerusalem Council Acts 15

Splits from Paul at beginning of 2nd journey Acts 15

Other mentions: 1 Corinthians and Colossians

TITUS

Not mentioned in Acts

Mentioned in 2 Corinthians

Sent by Paul to deal with issues in the church.

Sent back to receive an offering for the church in Jerusalem

Paul referred to Titus as his partner and fellow worker

Paul wrote the book of Titus

To encourage him to set things in order in Crete

One of three pastoral epistles.

Other mentions: 2 Timothy
