## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

I am quite excited to share with you how I was convicted just a couple of weeks ago after teaching the combined class of 2 year olds through 5th graders about the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah. It is a sad story and one that is good for us all to learn: in a very little nutshell, the cities were destroyed because there were NO righteous people living in them save Lot and his family; Lot's wife looked back at the city when the angel clearly told the family NOT to look back and she became a pillar of salt.

What do you teach little ones about the heart of this story? I think it is important to let the children know that sin, the "bad" things we think, say and do, separate us from God (destruction of the cities). It is also imperative to let them know that God offers a way to be saved from our sin when we trust in Jesus, His Son, who loved us so much that He chose to die on the Cross and rise again for the purpose of washing that sin away (bringing Lot and his family out of the cities). It is also important to encourage the kiddos to keep looking ahead to Jesus and not to long for the things of the world that can burden us and render us useless like a pillar of salt.

My mistake? Pretty much just telling the story but not helping the children understand the heart of it that I just mentioned above. I loved the crafts that we got to make, though!! (wonderful, yet so much NOT the most important part!!) However, while the crafts and snacks can be great reinforcements of the story, I want to make sure they reinforce the HEART of the story – or at least that the heart of it is what I emphasize while teaching, reenacting and enjoying the craft and snack time!

So there you go – apply as you see fit – and please pray that we who teach and assist in the children's ministry will be able to grasp and share the heart of the stories we teach to the precious souls in our midst!

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power." Ephesians 6:10





# WOMEN'S HOME FELLOWSHIP


