Game Instructions

Child rolls 3 balls up towards the holes. Child gets 1 piece of candy for lower hole, 2 for middle hole, and 3 for highest hole. Child receives 3 pieces if no balls go into holes.

Game Information

This game is the classic game of skee ball. The Biblical theme of this game is “Noah and the Flood”. While you most likely won’t be able to share the theme with every child, if the opportunity comes up, take advantage! If you get a group of kids, tell the theme to all of them at once, and then continue to play. All these kids need to hear the word of God and to learn that God loves them! Listed below are verses for you to read and memorize, a “how to” present the instructions for the game, and an example conversation you can have with a child to share the theme.

Game Instructions to Child

“Welcome to Noah’s Skeet Load! Noah was a man who lived a long time ago, and he really loved God. God was about to flood the earth, and he told Noah to build a giant ark (a huge boat) and put every kind of animal in the world on it! It’s your job to help Noah load the rest of these animals on the ark. You get 3 tries - roll each ball one at a time to try to get the animals inside the ark.”

Sharing God's Word-

“Noah obeyed God and put all the animals in the ark. Sometimes we don’t want to do what God wants us to do, but we know that God is trustworthy, and He knows what is best for us. We can trust Him with our life, just like Noah did. After the flood was over God put a rainbow in the sky as a sign of His promise that He would never flood the whole earth again.
