

## Ring Toss

Game Worker:  
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### Supplies List:

- game table
- tablecloth
- bottles
- rings
- loose hay
- basket
- candy bucket
- sign
- chairs

### Game Instructions

Child gets 5 rings to toss onto bottles. Smaller children may stand closer, larger children farther back. 1 piece of candy is given for every successful ring on a bottle. If they do not get a ring on a bottle, they receive 3 pieces of candy for trying.

### Game Information

This game is the classic ring toss game of tossing rings onto bottlenecks. The Biblical theme of “Jesus Turning Water into Wine” can be applied to this game. While you most likely won’t be able to share the theme with every child, if the opportunity comes up, take advantage! If you get a group of kids, tell the theme to all of them at once, and then continue to play. All these kids need to hear the word of God and to learn that God loves them! Listed below are verses for you to read and memorize, a “how to” present the instructions for the game, and an example conversation you can have with a child to share the theme.

### Conversation Example

#### *Game Instructions to Child*

“Step right up to the Ring Toss Game! You get 5 rings to toss onto those bottlenecks. For every bottle you get a ring around, you get a piece of candy.”

#### *Sharing God's Word*

“Those soda bottles remind me of a story about Jesus. Once Jesus attended a wedding and the hosts ran out of wine, so Jesus turned water into wine! How amazing is that? Jesus can do even more miracles than that. The Bible tells us stories of how Jesus multiplied food, healed sick people, and even brought people back from the dead.
