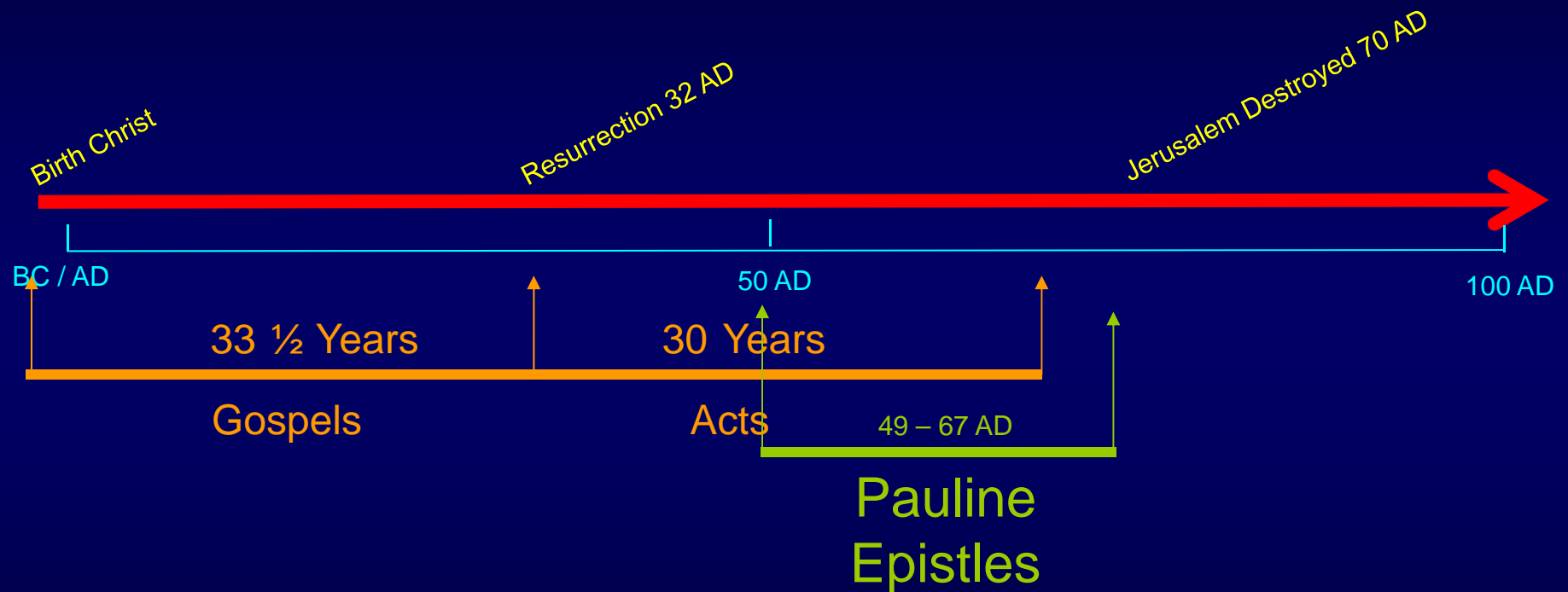

15	Offense → Many Died	Grace → Gift to Many
16	Offence → Condemnation	Free Gift → Justification
17	Offense → Death Reigned	Gracious Gift → Reigning In Life
18	Offense → Condemnation	Righteous Act → Justification Of Life
19	Disobedience → Many Made Sinners	Obedience → Many Made Righteous
21	Sin Reigned In Death	Grace Reigns Through Righteousness To Eternal Life

The Romans Road

Romans 3:23

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 10:9-10, 13

that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

For “whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”
